PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

[Under General Provisions of the Nationality Act of 1940 (Public, No. 853, 76th Cong.)]

To the Honorable the District Court of the United States at San Francisco, Calif.
This petition for naturalization, hereby made and filed, respectively shows:

(1) My full, true, and correct name is JOHN QUANE
(2) My present place of residence is 861 Sutter St., San Francisco, Calif. My occupation is accountant
(4) I am 64 years old. (5) I was born on August 27, 1879 in Ballaspet, Isle of Man
(6) My personal description is as follows: Sex male, color white, complexion fair, color of eyes gray, color of hair gray
height 5 feet 7 1/2 inches, weight 165 pounds, visible distinctive marks scar left forehead, race white
present nationality British (7) I am not married; the name of my wife consort is Minnie Rosina
we were married on July 5, 1904 at Christchurch, New Zealand
she was born at Queenstown, Otago, New Zealand on November 17, 1874
and entered the United States at San Francisco, Calif. on July 9, 1914 for permanent residence in the United States
and now reside sex with me and was naturalized on _____ at _____ certificate No. _____; or became a citizen by _____

(8) I have two children; and the name, sex, date and place of birth, and present place of residence of each of said children who is living, are as follows:
Irma Sylvia Quane, female, Sept. 17, 1905, Christchurch, New Zealand.
Maurice Ralph Quane, male, July 16, 1909, Christchurch, New Zealand.
Both reside in San Francisco, California.

(9) My last place of foreign residence was Christchurch, New Zealand (10) I emigrated to the United States from
Wellington, New Zealand
at San Francisco, California under the name of John Quane
on July 9, 1914 on the S.S. "Tahiti"
as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached to this petition.

(12) Since my lawful entry for permanent residence I have not been absent from the United States, for a period or periods of 6 months or longer, as follows:

(13) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on July 3, 1940 in the District
Court of the United States at San Francisco, Calif. (14) It is my intention in good faith to become a

citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, State, or sovereignty of whom or which at this time I am a subject or citizen, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (15) I am not, and have not been for the period of at least 10 years immediately preceding the date of this petition, an anarchist; nor a believer in the unlawful damage, injury, or destruction of property, or sabotage; nor a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government; nor a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposition to organized government. (16) I am able to speak the English language (unless physically unable to do so). (17) I am, and have been during all of the periods required by law, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. (18) I have resided continuously in the

United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since July 9, 1914
and continuously in the State in which this petition is made for the term of 6 months at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since
March, 1938 (19) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization: No. _____

(20) Attached hereto and made a part of this, my petition for naturalization, are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States (if such declaration of intention be required by the naturalization law), a certificate of arrival from the Immigration and Naturalization Service of my said lawful entry into the United States for permanent residence (if such certificate of arrival be required by the naturalization law), and the affidavits of at least two verifying witnesses required by law.
